- 1. Open to all youth 4 years old to 2nd Grade.
- 2. Show will be held on **Saturday**, **August 10th** at 12 O'clock Noon.
- 3. All Calves must be dairy calves born in May, June, July.
- 4. The Calf should be at least 2 weeks of Age.
- 5. Youth can show a calf from home or use a calf that is already at the fair in the open of junior shows.

However, if they so choose to use a calf already exhibited at the fair, they are responsible for making

the arrangement with the exhibitor, (this calf must be a May calf exhibited in the spring calf Class).

- 6. Calves from home will be brought in before the show and then taken home after.
- 7. Calves must be lead with a correct fitting halter.
- 8. Calf and Child must be a resident of Clark County
- 9. Limited to the first 50 children that enter.
