2024 Invasive Species Spraying

Invasive species within the road right-of-way and adjacent properties can pose significant health risks to highway workers, utility workers, emergency responders and anyone else utilizing the right-of-way. In the month of May, you may notice our crews spraying these areas to help control and eradicate Wild Parsnip and other harmful invasive weed species. Our staff has been trained and certified in applying EPA (Environmental Protection Agency) certified herbicides. These herbicides are plant specific and won't hurt native plants. This means grasses, milkweed and other native plants will flourish helping our wildlife and pollinators. Our intent is to spray all county roads and STH 29. No town roads will be sprayed. The window of opportunity will be dictated by weather, but we anticipate three (3) weeks of spraying, starting May 6th.

Herbicide formula to be used:

Plateau	241-365	Imazapic	4 oz/acre
Terravue	62719-738	Aminopyralid-potassium	2.5 oz/acre
MSO	Exempt	(Surfactant)	16 oz/acre
Compadre	228-386	(Drift control)	3 oz/acre
