Application Process for

SEASONAL WEIGHT EXEMPTION PERMIT

Submitted Permits must include:

- 1. Completed (and Signed) Application/Permit (Page 1)
- 2. Completed (Marked) Location Map (Page 2)

Please refer to the conditions stated below:

- a. A "divisible load" is any cargo being carried, which can be separated into units of legal weight without affecting the physical integrity of the load. Examples of divisible loads include: aggregate (sand, top soil, gravel, stone), logs, scrap metal, fuel, palletized goods (including perishable goods), etc. Divisible loads are not eligible for a permit.
- b. A "non-divisible load" is any cargo being carried which cannot be separated into units of less weight without affecting the physical integrity of the load. Examples of nondivisible loads include, but are not limited to; a single pole, single column, single vehicle, bulk milk and raw septic waste from the originating source to the final destination. Any special circumstances would need to be discussed with the Highway Commissioner for review.
- c. All vehicles above the maximum weight are required to have a permit.
- d. This permit shall be filled out by the transporting individual, <u>not</u> the receiving individual. The approved permit shall be in the transporting vehicle to be valid.
- e. This permit is not valid unless signed. Any attempt to receive a verbal permit is not allowed.
- f. Application form shall be filled out completely, <u>including signature of the company</u> representative. Leaving any information blank will result in the denial of permit.
- g. The permit shall include a <u>marked</u> route map. The starting point, delivery/pickup address, direction of travel and end point should be clearly labeled.
- h. This permit is only valid for county trunk highways. Any weight restrictions on State, City, Village or Township roads are handled by each respective entity.

SINGLE AXLE: SIX (6) TONS


For a single-axle vehicle, you are allowed six tons for the front steer axle and six tons for the rear drive axle—a grand total of 12 tons, or 24,000 pounds.

TANDEM AXLE: TEN (10) TONS

For a tandem axle vehicle, you are allowed six tons for the front steer axle and ten tons total for the rear tandem drive axles—a grand total of 16 tons, or 32,000 pounds.

VEHICLES WITH AN ADDITIONAL TAG OR PUSHER AXLE:

If you have an additional, independent pusher axle or tag axle with suspension independent of the suspension of the tandem drive axles, you are allowed an additional six tons for that axle—a grand total of 22 tons, or 44,000 pounds. These are typically described as tri-axle vehicles.



This is the weight limit sign used as an example for this document.

STATE STATUTE 348.01 (2) (C) - DEFINITION OF TANDEM AXLE

"'Tandem axle' means any 2 or more consecutive axles whose centers are 42 or more inches apart and which are individually attached to or articulated from, or both, a common attachment to the vehicle including a connecting mechanism designed to equalize the load between axles."
