The Clark County Health Department (CCHD) will be facilitating off-site flu clinics in October!

The high-dose flu vaccine for people 65 years of age & older may be available. Availability depends on inventory. We anticipate a high demand for the high-dose flu vaccine this season. High-dose flu vaccine provides better protection against influenza for this age group, compared to a standard-dose flu vaccine.
